



Public Workshop for the I-25/Cañoncito Exit 294 Interchange Project

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) will conduct a workshop to gather public input on alternatives to improve the I-25/Cañoncito Exit 294 Interchange located in Santa Fe County. The project area is between mile posts 292.5 and 294.5 on I-25. The Exit 294 Interchange is located approximately 4 miles north of the US 285/Eldorado interchange.

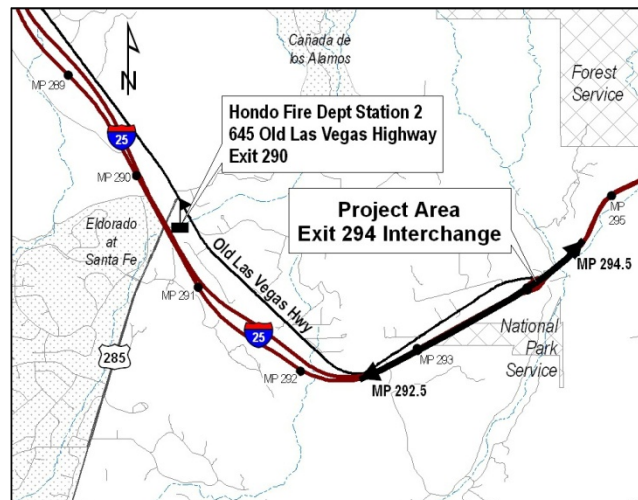
Workshop Date and Time: **Saturday, May 12, 2012; 9:00 AM to 12:00 Noon**

Workshop Location: **Hondo Volunteer Fire Department Station 2, 645 Old Las Vegas Highway,
Exit 290 at I-25/US 285, Santa Fe, NM 87508**

The purpose of the project is to replace the existing concrete box culvert underpass and to address other transportation needs at the interchange. The existing interchange has short ramps that make entering and exiting the interstate difficult.

The primary purpose of the public workshop is to solicit input from stakeholders and the community on a range of alternatives including:

- Moving the interchange 600 ft. to the west
- Moving the interchange 4,000 ft. to the west
- Replacing the box culvert and extending the on and off ramps at the existing location
- Closing the interchange and replacing the box culvert



Participants should arrive by 9 AM and plan to stay for the entire workshop, which will include a short introduction, interactive topic tables, and a short summary session.
