C. ITEMS for DISCUSSION and POSSIBLE ACTION:

1. FFY 2018 Safety Targets for New Mexico –MPO Staff

The Santa Fe MPO in conjunction with the NMDOT and statewide MPOs are recommending that each Policy Board adopt the NMDOT prescribed “(FFY) Safety Targets as required by Title 23 CFR 490, Final Rule on the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) published March 15, 2016 (effective April 14, 2017). The state is required to set annual targets for five performance measures:

1. Number of Fatalities
2. Rate of Fatalities per 100 million vehicle miles travelled (VMT)
3. Number of Serious Injuries
4. Rate of Serious Injuries per 100 million VMT
5. Number of Non-motorized Fatalities and Serious Injuries

Attached is a summary of the safety targets selected for each category and a summary of the methodology used to derive the targets.

2. FFY 2018 Transit Asset Management Targets

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) developed “Final Rule” making requiring transit providers to set performance targets for state of good repair by January 1, 2017. The Planning Rule requires each MPO to establish said targets thereafter.
