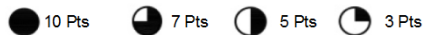





#### **Amendment 3 to the FY2014-2017 TIP Approved on February 27<sup>th</sup>, 2014 by the Santa Fe MPO Transportation Policy Board**

The Santa Fe Metropolitan Planning Organization hereby certifies that the following amendments were conducted in accordance with all applicable requirements of 23 CFR 450.218 and 23 CFR 450.324 and the federal transit requirements of Section 5307(c) (1-7). The TIP Amendments were made available to the public via a notice in the local newspaper, through email distribution lists and on the MPO website. A 15-day public comment period was held from February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2014 through February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

The projects and revisions that were part of the amendment are as follows:

**CN:S100130 – Cerrillos Road Reconstruction Phase IIC**

- Change in Project Termini to extend from St Michaels Dr to Llano St on Cerrillos Rd (NM14) and Add the section of St Michaels Dr (NM466) from Cerrillos Rd to Llano St for Traffic Signal Conduit Installation. No Change in Funding  
**Federal Funds = \$8,116,800; State Match = \$1,383,200; Project Total = \$9,500,000**

**CN:S100280 – Santa Fe River Trail – Connections and Improvements**

- Phase 2 of the project removed from Scope as it is moving slower and is fully funded with City GO Bond funds. Project cost reduced from \$1,290,000 to \$300,000. Amount of TAP funding remains the same.  
**TAP Federal Funds = \$250,000; Local Match = \$42,603; Local Non Match = \$7,397; Project Total = \$300,000**

**CN:S100283 – Gonzales Community School Bike and Pedestrian Safety Improvements & Bike Rack Purchase**

- Project SRTS Funding increased from \$173,242 to \$272,422 to reflect revised cost estimate.  
**SRTS Federal Funds = \$272,422 (100% Federal Funds);**

**CN:S100330 – Santa Fe River Trail Crossing at St Francis Drive at West Alameda**

- New Project funded with City CO Bond funds for the design and construction of a grade separated multi-use trail crossing of St Francis Drive.  
**Federal Funds = \$0; City GO Bond Funds = \$2,000,000; Project Total = \$2,000,000**

- Carry over of Federal Funds not Obligated in FFY2013 and now being programed in FFY2014. \$500,000 Obligated in FFY2013, Total Project cost = \$600,000
