FHWA received FY2014 – FY2017 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Amendment #6. The STIP was found to be in compliance with 23 U.S.C. 134, 135, and 49 U.S.C. 5303-5305. This constitutes your joint FHWA-NM and FTA Region VI approval letter to your request.

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) has provided the required self-certification and public involvement assurances that the STIP was developed in accordance to the New Mexico DOT STIP Policies and Procedures. The documentation submitted demonstrates fiscal constraint by showing that the proposed expenditure of Federal funds for each of the four fiscal years is within the anticipated obligation limitation for each of those years.

FHWA-NM would like to recognize NMDOT efforts in addressing the HSIP program through an innovative approach to advance the State transportation safety program. In order to strengthen this approach, we are requesting that the NMDOT provide the following information in advance of the next STIP approval request:

- Detailed explanation of the means by which it will be implementing its required Civil Rights programs: Title VI, Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE), Contractor Compliance, Internal State Equal Employment Opportunity, and Americans with Disability Act (ADA). The explanation needs to clearly describe how the Civil Rights programs will operate as a unit and how the different elements, including other program areas relate to each other and meet all Federal requirements. Also, the Title VI Coordinator must be a direct report to the Secretary.
- Description of the "Price Agreement" element of the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) as reference in Mr. Michael Sandoval, Director of Planning and Safety Division letter of September 26, 2014. The document needs to clearly describe the elements of the program and how the elements will relate to each other, the process to be followed and the responsible party for implementation.
