### Santa Fe MPO Staff Report

**Technical Coordinating Committee: September 25, 2023** 

**Matter of Approval**: Release Amendment #4 to the Metropolitan Transportation Plan and Amendment #2 to the Bicycle Master Plan for 30 day public comment.

#### **Background:**

The MPO issued a call for new projects for the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) and Bicycle Master Plan (BMP) at the previous TCC meeting. The intent is to update the projects lists annually between formal plan updates.

New proposed projects to add to the MTP include:

- 33 NCRTD Station for electric buses
- 44 Rodeo Bridge Reconstruction over St. Francis to add bike lanes and sidewalks
- 53 Study: NM592 bicycle and safety improvements from Tesuque Village Road to Rio en Medio
- 22 Cordova road diet
- 60 Federal Place Study (two way or one way with two way bike lane)
- 45 Study Paseo de Peralta Road Diet Bishop's Lodge to St. Francis
- Little Tesuque Creek Trailhead and NCRTD Bus Stop

#### New proposed projects to add to the BMP include:

- 1. Paved Trail between old Taos and Bishops Lodge through Ft Marcy park phase C
- 2. Fin de Sendero bike lanes between La Tierra and Lluvia de Oro phase B
- 3. Study bike route/bike lanes between Lluvia de Oro and Tano Road phase C
- 4. Galisteo redesign to include a sidepath on the east side phase C
- 5. Camino Griego Trail unused road alignment
- 6. River Trail Agua Fria Connector Future trailhead east of South Meadows
- 7. Tierra Contenta Trail: TC3 to Nina Otero along Capitol High border
- 8. Tierra Contenta Trail: South Meadows to Jemez
- 9. Arroyo de los Chamisos Trail: North of arroyo from future Richards to Camino de los Arroyos
- 10. Richards Sidepath: Beckner to Rabbit Road
- 11. Richards Sidepath: Beckner to Rabbit roundabout westside
- 12. Richards to Pinon ES Trail
- 13. Pueblos del Sol to Governor Miles Connection
- 14. Pueblos del Sol Connector 1
- 15. Arroyo Chaparral Trail & Bridge
- 16. Ragle Park Connector
- 17. Canada Ancha Trail Soft surface trail along Hyde Park to Little Tesuque Creek
- 18. Buckman Track Spectator Trail

- 19. NM599 Frontage Trail/Underpass Connector to the west to Mirada Rd.
- 20. Water Line to Camino La Tierra Trail
- 21. Saleh Subdivision NMCRR
- 22. NMCRR Eldorado Connection North
- 23. NMCRR Connection South
- 24. Chili Line to East Wildflower (west of La Tierra)
- 25. New Moon to Mesa Bonita Connector
- 26. Siringo and St. Francis intersection to the Rail Trail
