**B. APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

**MOTION** A motion was made by Mr. Denton, seconded by Mr. Tomas Martinez, to approve the agenda as presented.

**1. COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC**

**Patricia Hale.** Ms. Hale said she thinks the Carbon Reduction Plan is good. She would like to see more public transit and efforts to make Santa Fe more urban and easier to get around in without a car. She supports electric vehicles and buses. Be careful where you buy them from. Sometimes they can explode. The more walking and biking trails the better.

**2. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION**

**A. PRESENTATION: REVIEW AND RECOMMEND 2023 CARBON REDUCTION STRATEGY**

Ms. Glendening gave a Power Point presentation outlining the 2023 Carbon Reduction Study.

**B. REVIEW AND RECOMMEND: UPDATE TO THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN AND BICYCLE MASTER PLAN PROJECT LISTS VIS SELF-CERTIFICATION**

Ms. Yngve shared her screen and reviewed the staff memo in the packet saying there have been only minor changes made since the last time this Committee reviewed this item.

Mr. Snyder said he would like more details about the trail that has been added.

Ms. Yngve said this was a request from Councilor Cassutt for an additional direct trail to connect the river trail to Romero Park so that the neighborhood would be connected.

Chair Glorioso-Moss asked if the projects have been prioritized.

Ms. Yngve said they have not, but will be integrated this week with the existing project list. We will do that with the scores. They are prioritized within their categories.

Chair Glorioso-Moss said she needs that information when she is applying for funding and to answer questions from constituents.

Mr. Snyder asked if that trail extension that was added is a City or County trail.

This is the first time we have heard anything about it. It will transverse County land. He feels that they should have been included in that conversation.

Ms. Yngve apologized that they did not reach out.

Mr. Aune said if the desire is to remove it he would support that. It should have come to you.

Mr. Tomas Martinez said if it has not gone to the County, we need to remove it until they have time to vet it.

**MOTION** A motion was made by Mr. Tomas Martinez, seconded by Mr. Denton, to recommend approval of the update with the trail extension in question excluded.

**VOTE** The motion passed on a voice vote.

**C. REVIEW AND RECOMMEND: ADOPTION OF THE 2024 SANTA FE MPO COMMITTEE MEETING CALENDAR**

Mr. Aune reviewed the proposed calendar.

**MOTION** A motion was made by Mr. Tomas Martinez, seconded by Mr. Clavio, to recommend adoption of the 2024 Santa Fe MPO Committee meeting calendar.

**VOTE** The motion passed on a voice vote.

**D. SAFETY STUDY OPTIONS: SANTA FE COUNTY**

Mr. Galizio said at the Board of County Commissioners meeting the Commissioners asked for a safety study of the Highway 14 intersection south of 599. He would defer to Commissioner Hughes.

Commissioner Hughes has temporarily left the meeting.

Mr. Aune explained the process and project saying this was for a specific intersection and relates to the high speed volume of traffic. The discussion was requested to develop options for the County to consider.

Mr. Aune suggested that a Road Safety Audit be done for this intersection.

Mr. Tomas Martinez asked if anyone had looked to see what the traffic accident report looks like.

Mr. Snyder said yes we have. The numbers do not show a large number of incidents there. This came up in relation to the recent incident of a fatality, which brought this intersection into the forefront. The County has initiated a request to DOT for a stop sign.

Mr. Javier Martinez said we made a commitment to trimming some of the bushes to improve site distance. His suggestion is to obtain a flash sign that flashes only when a vehicle approaches.

Mr. Galizio said the Commissioner has returned. This is a good opportunity to hear from him.

Commissioner Hughes said the issues at this intersection came to light with the accident at Bonanza Creek Road. It seemed like a good idea for us to keep an eye on that road. There are a lot of constituent concerns. Also we need to keep an eye on some of the intersections closer to the City as traffic increases. He is glad to hear some of the improvements considered for Bonanza Creek Road.

Mr. Aune said it sounds like a good conversation is happening. The MPO can offer to do some modeling of New Mexico 14 as to future growth and volume that might help the County.

Chair Glorioso-Moss asked what does the County need from this Committee to move forward.

Mr. Galizio said he is hearing that the problem is being addressed and we should monitor the intersections. It sounds like we don't need to do anything at this time.

Commissioner Hughes said he is interested in Eric's offer, but he would defer to staff.

Mr. Javier Martinez said from time to time developments are required to do a traffic impact study when a development occurs. That is another way to obtain information at other intersections. We can share the traffic counts.

Mr. Aune said there are options on the table. If the County has ideas to bring forward just call him.

Mr. Clavio said this is a very busy intersection. We need to look at what warrants a traffic signal.

Mr. Javier Martinez said we can look at traffic counts to see when a signal is warranted. That is the process.

**3. MATTERS FROM MPO STAFF**

Mr. Aune said we are wrapping up the calendar year. Typically we do not meet in December. Thank you all for a good year of work.

**4. MATTERS FROM TCC MEMBERS**

Mr. Clavio said there will be a Santa Fe Transportation Advisory Committee meeting this Wednesday at 4:00 pm.

Ms. Glendening said she will be sending out information on crashes this week.

Mr. Gibson said we just kicked off our Santa Fe Siting Study for a Santa Fe Operations Center. He will have more to share in January or February.

Chair Glorioso-Moss said the Guadalupe Bridge will be completed the second week of December. Then we will move to the reconstruction of Guadalupe Street. We will do public engagement. Thank you everyone.
