Matter of Discussion: Transportation Project Fund (TPF) Project Rankings

Background:

The State Transportation Project Fund applications are due May 31st. The MPO follows the process of agency staff submitting Project Feasibility Forms (PFFs) to the MPO and reviewing with NMDOT District 5 and the TCC before proceeding with selected full applications.

The City and County submitted a total of 3 PFFs for a total of over \$4 million requested. We are estimating that approximately \$2-4 million in TPF funds will be available for the Santa Fe metropolitan planning area.

The MPO has provided the attached draft ranking for discussion. The TPF ranking criteria include:

- 1. Planning
- 2. Project readiness
- 3. Priority bridges
- 4. Phasing
- 5. Additional MPO criteria

The MPO uses additional ranking criteria established by the Metropolitan Transportation Plan:

- Safety & Security
- System Preservation
- Multimodal Mobility & Accessibility
- Congestion Relief & System Operations
- Economic & Community Vitality
- Greenhouse Gas Reduction
- Partnership & Funding

Additionally, the MPO and NMDOT District 5 aspire to include some funding for all agencies that submit applications.
